

## PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION IN NETHERLANDS

### YOUR RIGHTS AS THE DATA SUBJECTS IN NETHERLANDS

- 1. Right to be Informed**  
You have the right to know how your data is being used.
- 2. Right to Access**  
You can request to see the data held about you.
- 3. Right to Rectification**  
You can ask to correct inaccurate data about you.
- 4. Right to Erasure**  
You can request to delete your data.
- 5. Right to Object/Opt-Out**  
You can object to the processing of your data.
- 6. Right to Data Portability**  
You can request to move your data to another service.
- 7. Right not to be Subject to Automated Decision-Making**  
You can refuse decisions made only by automated processes.
- 8. Other Rights**  
The Act does not introduce additional rights beyond those provided by GDPR.
- 9. Variations of GDPR on the Right to Restriction of Processing**  
You can limit how your data is used in certain cases.
